How to Apply

1. Go to the [scholarship](#) page on our website.
2. Select the relevant scholarship link.
3. This will take you to the scholarship website.
4. Read the scholarship terms before applying.
5. You will need to create a new account the first time you visit each separate scholarship page.
6. You can do this by clicking on 'Log In' at the very top right of the page and a log in pop up window will appear.
7. Click on 'Need to create an account' at the bottom.
8. Complete the details required in the new pop up and click create.
9. You will be directed back to the scholarship home page.
10. Click 'Start application'.
11. Enter your personal details.
12. Upload a small profile photo and add a biography if you wish.
13. Click 'Save & Continue' or just 'Save'.
14. You can now log back in if you need to complete your submission at a later date.
15. Click 'Next' to complete your submission.
16. Be sure to provide as much detail as possible.
17. You can upload any supporting evidence eg. conference program, course outline etc.
18. Provide the name and email of two referees, **if required**, and click 'Next' to review your submission.
19. Once you hit 'Submit' you will not be able to make any further changes.

Other financial support	Full financial support has been received OR has not responded to this question	The applicant has received some financial support and/or other benefits (scholarship, paid leave) but it does not cover the entire budget	The applicant has received no financial support but has received other benefits (e.g. paid leave)	Not received any additional financial support including paid leave or other benefits
Overall application quality	Incomplete or unclear, no link to scholarship objectives or no indication of benefits to the wider community	The application is poorly written and/or is weakly linked to the scholarship objectives and/or limited demonstration of benefits to the wider community	The application is well written, with moderate links to the scholarship objectives and moderately demonstrates benefits to the wider community	Well written, with strong links to scholarship objectives and shows benefits to the wider community
